

## *Subiaco Academy Graduation Requirements*

- **Computer Applications** ½ \*Unit (or Equivalency test)
- **Digital Learning** ½ unit of a course (Requirement is met with Benedictine Spirituality)
- **English** 4 units
- **Foreign Language** 2 units (A minimum of two units of the same language)
- **Health** ½ unit
- **History** 3 units (must include 1 unit Western Civilization; 1 unit US History; 1/2 unit Civics, or US Government; and 1/2 unit Economics)
- **Mathematics** 4 units
- **Oral Communications** ½ unit
- **Physical Education** ½ unit
- **Religious Studies** Each semester and the Senior Retreat
- **Science** 3 units (at least 1 unit of a life science and 1 unit of a physical science)
- **Visual and Performing Arts** 2 units

\*½ unit = 1 semester; 1 unit = 1 year

Students must be enrolled in English and mathematics each year and enrollment in a science course each year is strongly recommended.

**Students should also complete 20 hours of community service per year.**

Electives to complete requirements

Exceptions to the above sequence may be granted by the Academic Dean. For example: If a freshman wishes to postpone a requirement such as Foreign Language or Civics in order to take Chorus or Jazz Ensemble, this permission may be granted by the Academic Dean.
